SUBJECT: COVID-19 PROCEDURES FOR COUNTY DIVISION

DATED: JULY 13, 2020

This County Division Administrative Order is entered in response to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and pursuant to General Administrative Order 2020-02 entered on June 26, 2020 by Chief Judge Timothy C. Evans.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The following procedures will be in place for the County Division effective immediately.

I. REMOTE HEARINGS

All matters within the County Division will be conducted by Zoom videoconference unless a case is specially set for an in-person trial or hearing. The Zoom meeting numbers and passwords for each calendar judge are set forth below.

A. Remote Hearings For All Matters Except Mental Health, Adoption, and Waiver of Parental Rights Cases

The following Zoom meeting ID numbers and passwords should be used to join proceedings for cases on the appropriate calendar, excluding Calendar 2.

B. *Mental Health Cases – Calendar 2*

- 1) Mental Health Case Management. The daily mental health case management call on Calendar 2 will be held under a separate Zoom ID number, which will be provided to the attorneys handling the call. Only attorneys, respondents, and court personnel will be provided with the meeting information to preserve any confidentiality associated with the call.
- 2) Mental Health Hearings. Cases assigned to Calendar 2 that are set for a mental health hearing will be assigned a new meeting ID for the judge presiding over the hearing, unless directed otherwise by the Court. Only attorneys, respondents, court personnel, and designated witnesses will be provided with the meeting information to preserve any confidentiality associated with the proceeding.
- 3) Emergency Writs. Counsel should email Maureen.marchese@cookcountyil.gov or call 312-603-6194 to schedule and obtain zoom meeting information for an emergency writ.

B. Additional Scheduling Information.

- 1) **Name Changes.** Petitioners may contact Korin Navarro at Korin.navarro@cookcountyil.gov to receive information as to what documents need to be presented to the Court at the Zoom Videoconference hearing. Typically, the court requires Illinois photo identification, birth certificate and proof of publication. These documents can be e filed or emailed if an exemption from e-filing prior to the hearing.
- 2) **Tax Deed Cases.** Prove-ups may be scheduled after July 31, 2020. Prove-ups scheduled for a remote proceeding shall use the Zoom Meeting information set forth in Section I(A) for the calendar to which the case is assigned. Petitioner shall provide copies of the Application for Tax Deed and all exhibits to be presented at the prove up to the calendar judge at the email

- 3) Tax Objection Cases: Status and Pre-trials. The remote procedures for tax objection cases are set forth in County Division Administrative Order 2020-4, issued June 1, 2020 and discussed in the 10.8 Committee Memo dated July 7, 2020. The schedule for pretrial and status for each calendar judge is set forth in Section II(A) above.
- 4) Civil Asset Forfeiture Cases. Monday and Wednesday court dates are only for Preliminary Hearings, Return Dates and Case management. Trials are heard on Tuesday and Thursday. To confirm your Zoom hearing you may contact the State's Attorney's Office at (312) 603-6462. The Zoom Meeting information is set forth in Section I(A).

III. 298 FEE WAIVER PETITIONS

Fee waiver petitions will be forwarded to the assigned calendar judge for ruling based on the written Petition. The Court may request the petitioner to appear by audio or video conference.

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
