notice, the Plaintiff will be asking the court to allow the sheriff to evict you based on that judgment.

To prevent the eviction, you must be able to prove that:

1. the Plaintiff and you made an agreement after the judgment (for instance, to pay up back rent or to comply with the lease) and you have lived up to the agreement; or
2. the reason that the Plaintiff brought the original eviction case has been resolved or forgiven, and the eviction the Plaintiff now wants the court to grant is based on a new or different reason; or
3. that you have another legal or equitable reason why the court should not grant the Plaintiff's request for your eviction."
