7 EASY STEPS -

To Obtain Your Illinois Rap Sheet

The Illinois fingerprint-based "Access and Review" authorizes an individual to review their entire Illinois criminal history record information "rap sheet" in order to ensure its accuracy. This check will require you to be fingerprinted in order to guarantee positive biometric fingerprint identification.

Step 1: Locate the nearest Accurate Biometrics fingerprint site to your home residence or work via our website.

AccurateBiometrics.com

Step 2: Enter your "Location" zip code to search for the site nearest you.

Step 3: Determine when the site nearest you is open, **No appointments are necessary**, just walk in.

Step 4: Bring your Drivers License or State ID with you to the site, confirming your resident address.

Step 5: Payment for services is due at the time fingerprints are taken.

Step 6: Fingerprint and demographic data are captured and transmitted to the Illinois State Police for processing the same day.

Step 7: Your entire Illinois criminal history record information response will be mailed to your confirmed home resident address.

NEW LAW: ALL FELONIES ELIGIBLE TO BE SEALED

with Four Exceptions

Effective August 24, 2017, the Illinois Legislature expanded the sealing of criminal records of adults and of minors prosecuted as adults. The new law EXPANDS THE SEALING LAW TO ALLOW FOR ALMOST ALL FELONIES TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR SEALING, with only four exceptions:

- (1) DUIs and reckless driving; (2) animal crimes;
- (3) sex offenses (exception prostitution and misdemeanor public indecency);
- (4) domestic battery and violations of orders of protection.
