Dorothy Brown Remembers Morgan Carter

A Great Communicator and Community Supporter, Carter Died Nov. 16

(Chicago) — “He was called the ‘The World’s Conversation Starter’ because he was truly dedicated to creating opportunities for dialogue, and promoting open communication among people, especially concerning issues that affect the African-American community,” said Dorothy Brown, Clerk of the Circuit Court of Cook County, Illinois, about Morgan D. Carter, who died early morning on Sunday, November 16. “He was a great supporter of mine, often covering news from the Clerk’s Office in his newspaper, *Chicago Communicator*, or promoting our public services and community events on his radio and television programs, including Chicago Media Connection on channel 19.

“Morgan enjoyed a long and illustrious career in public relations, promotion and media, and his level of knowledge and expertise was of great value to our community,” Clerk Brown added. “The ‘Morgan Memos’ that he created for the Internet provided a wealth of information to interested persons worldwide. In a career that spanned more than 30 years, Morgan distinguished himself as a man who used his unique skills to enhance the public images of people of color.

“My heart goes out to his wife Wanda, who produced Morgan’s television programs and was his greatest supporter,” Clerk Brown continued. “Hopefully, she knows that there is a great number of people who knew and respected Morgan, and dearly miss his presence.”
